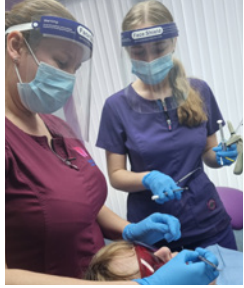

## Do you know what it takes to be a dental nurse?



A dental nurse is an assistant who works closely with a dentist, assisting in all aspects of patient care. Dental nurses have a huge knowledge of dentistry. Some of the responsibilities of a dental nurse include:

- Preparation of appropriate instruments
- Correct infection control
- Surgery preparation and sterilizing of instruments
- Patient care
- Preparation of materials to make fillings.
- Completion of patient notes
- Ensuring confidentiality is always correctly followed
- Equipment maintenance

Dental nursing provides a solid career and offers plenty of opportunity for continued training and development.

This is great for those looking at the long-term plan for their career and those who wish to work their way up the ladder through continued learning, experience and hard work.

If you want to become a qualified dental nurse you will need to undergo the required training course which can take up to two years to complete. It gives you an opportunity to still earn a living whilst you are learning.

To be a dental nurse you must have the following skill set:

- A high level of manual dexterity (be good with your hands)
- Excellent attention to detail

## Unable to attend your appointment? Please let us know!

## PRACTICE ARRIVAL PROTOCOL



As you might be aware cases of covid are on the rise and the virus is always around. The following protocol remains in place permanently for our patients arrival to the practice. This involves:

- The car park is available for patient use only.
- On arrival, contact the reception team via telephone or via the intercom on the front or back door to inform us of your arrival.
- You may come into the waiting room at the time of their appointment if you wish to do so. Alternatively you can wait outside in the car park area.
- Please attend on your own unless absolutely necessary.
- Please disinfect your hands on entering (and leaving) using the auto-dispense hand sanitisers at each entrance.
- The one-way system through the practice will remain as much as reasonably practicable.



## Dental Volunteer Work

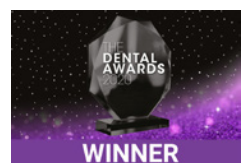
